Martin Luther King Holiday

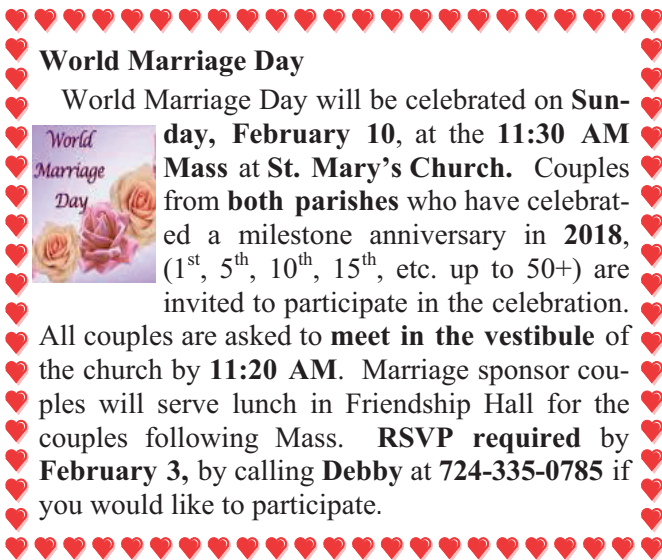
