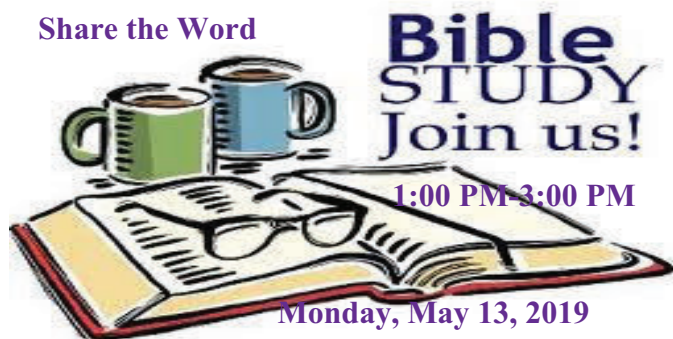

Eight 7th and 8th grade students presented their science projects at the 85th Annual Region 7 meeting of PJAS held on Saturday, February 2, 2019, at Duquesne University. The following students received a **first place award** and will present their projects at the main campus of Penn State University in May.
