On Tuesday and Wednesday, there is an evening Mass for the convenience of those who are not able to attend in the early morning, and on Friday, a noon Mass. We will try this schedule through Lent and Easter and see if any further adjustments are needed.

Mission Cooperative Appeal

Sr. Dorothy Fabritze, MSC, representing the Circus Ministry, will be at St. Joseph and St. Mary Parishes next weekend to talk about her work among the itinerant communities of the circus. The Catholic Church in the USA has a history of reaching out to these communities since the 1920's.

These often neglected traveling communities have the same spiritual needs to be educated in their faith, receive the sacraments, and be spiritually fed.

Unfortunately, because they do not have roots in any geographical location, they do not have the physical structures that would provide for this need. Sr. Dorothy will be here to speak about her experiences of travelling with the circus people for 19 years, her ministry to these people, and some exciting plans for the future.

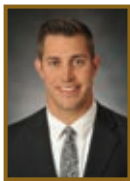
