Many thanks to all who volunteered their time and talent to make the Polish Platter Dinner a huge success this year! We sold 948 take-out dinners and served 480 dinners in Friendship Hall. The dedication of so many parishioners and especially the kitchen crew is awesome. May God continue to bless your efforts on behalf of our parish community.

While some additional donations continue to come in, we show a profit this year of more than \$19,000 (up from almost \$15,000 in 2018).

A number of people have asked if we would be able to share our recipe for the stuffed cabbage. We are happy to oblige.

**St. Mary of Czestochowa Stuffed Cabbage**

Mix together:

- 240 lbs. ground beef
- 50 lbs. rice
- 50 lbs. onions
- 4 dozen eggs
- salt, pepper, various herbs and spices
- some other stuff

Stuff cabbage leaves and cook in roasters until done. Makes approximately 1,746 cabbage rolls.

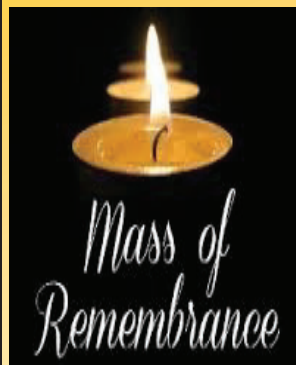

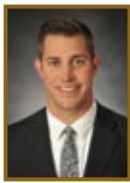

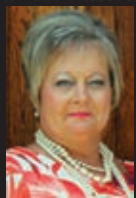
